Infants, Toddlers and 1s


Our youngest campers will experience full and fun days of playing and learning. Your little ones will keep busy throughout the day with age-appropriate in our indoor playground, as well as, in our outdoor water park. Children will be cared for by our Preschool professionals, and given enormous amounts of love!

Traditional Camp 2s, 3s, Pre K/K

Each week campers will enjoy a different theme, and days will be filled with related activities and a special guest. Campers will explore drama, art, sports, storytelling, experience science, music, and ruach (spirit), as well as, our indoor playground and outdoor waterpark several times a week!

Our older campers (entering Pre K & Kindergarten) will experience all of the fun traditional camp activities, as well as a weekly field trip. Our campers will also engage in yoga, sports, and movement! All campers will end their week with an all camp Shabbat in CBI's Chapel.

Teachers and counselors are mature, positive role models with preschool and day camp experience. They are sure to emphasize Jewish values, Israeli activities, and Judaic programming during the camp day. Physical and emotional safety are primary for our camp professionals. Specialty Camps

This exciting specialty camp program is designed to offer campers the opportunity to spend their days immersed in some of their favorite activities or learn about something new! Each week of camp will include hours of fun activities around the theme plus waterplay, Jewish enrichment, and a field trip. With professionals from the community, we will open the doors to many new and fascinating experiences. Our Specialty Camp is a 5 day, 9:00 AM-3:00 PM program. Our campers will enjoy time with their specialist from 9-12:30 PM each day, and then will participate in traditional camp activities from 1-3:00 PM.

Although many sessions are two weeks, you can sign up by the week. No activities will be repeated so there will be something new to learn and create every day!

Pirate Parade (1 week)

Ahoy, mateys! Jump on our pirate ship as we sail off for a week of exciting adventures! Our campers will sail the seven seas, looking for treasure and playing pirate games. 
Silly Scientists (2 weeks)

Camp Policies

Please read the registration procedure before filling out this form. Incorrect or incomplete forms will be returned without processing and you will not be registered. Registration cannot be processed without the full appropriate deposits or with an outstanding balance from any CBI program.

All camp fees must be paid in full by April 13, 2018.

Please initial next to each policy and sign below. As a parent/legal guardian of this registered camper, I understand and agree to the following policies:

- ____ Any changes in enrollment will be subject to cancellation and change fees. (\$10.00 charge per change, per child). A cancellation fee of \$100 will be charged for complete withdrawal from camp before April 13, 2018. Withdrawals from camp between April 7, 2017 and the first day of camp will be charged a cancellation fee of \$200. After the first day of camp, there will be no refunds for any reason. There will be no refunds for days of camp missed. Withdrawals from camp must be requested in writing.
- ____ Every child must have a current Medical Emergency Form on file prior to the first day of camp.
- ____ All campers are required to have all age appropriate, up to date vaccines. Parents will provide notice of updated immunizations as they are received.
- ____ CBI may use any photos, slides, or quotes in our publications and general media.
- ____ The Camp Director reserves the right to dismiss a camper whose physical condition, mental condition, behavior, personal conduct, or influence on other campers is deemed detrimental to the camp atmosphere. Should this occur, the deposit and unused camp fees will NOT be refunded.
- ____ To receive the Member billing rate for camp, you must be in good standing with CBI and have no outstanding dues. You must be a CBI member at the time of registration to receive member rates.
- ____ My name and phone number may be listed in all Camper Group Lists.
- ____ I give my child permission to walk to any of the Temple's buildings for all Shabbat Services, Indoor Playground, Art Studio and Special Events, participate in messy play, and participate in water play with sprinklers.
- ____ Camp Simcha and Chanen Preschool are nut sensitive facilities. No peanut or tree nut products may be brought to camp.

I understand that this is a contract that extends until the end of the camp season. I understand and acknowledge that CBI will be purchasing for services that will be provided to my child based on my enrollment, and I understand that I am legally obligated to pay the tuition for the full session in which my child is registered. I further acknowledge that there are no allowances made for absences or for camp holidays. In case of sudden injury or illness, I hereby give authority to any hospital or doctor to render immediate aid as may be required at the time for my child's health and safety. I understand that medical expenses are my responsibility. I hereby assume all risks (injury or illness) for my child and family members may occur during participation in any activity or use of facilities owned or rented by CBI. I hereby agree to and in no way hold management of CBI, agents or employees liable for lost or damages belongings or injury that my child may sustain.
