

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Applicant and/or Co-Applicant must be Congregation Beth Israel members in good standing or immediate family members (Child, Grandchild, Sibling) of current members in good standing.
- 2. Female applicants must be between 21-45 years of age. Male applicants must be between 21 and 50 years of age.
- 3. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or legal resident.
- 4. Applicant must have a need for advanced reproductive technology treatments as determined by a Reproductive Endocrinologist.
- 5. The grant may be used toward fertility treatments at any fertility clinic that is a member of the Society for Assisted Reproductive Technology (SART).
- 6. The *Mishpacha* Project funds a range of procedures including (but not limited to) egg retrieval, intrauterine insemination, in vitro fertilization, PGT-A (genetic testing), FDA testing, ICSI, monitoring, medications, etc. Checks will be made to the fertility clinic or pharmacist, and not to the individual applicant.
- 7. Applicants must possess the means to offer continued child support (at least one partner must maintain employment).
- 8. Recipients must begin treatment within 12 months of receiving a grant.
- 9. Applicants must have basic health insurance for mother and baby with sufficient prenatal coverage.
- 10. We are an inclusive community grants are available to same-sex couples, heterosexual couples and singles.
- 11. Applicant cannot have a medical condition that is a contraindication to achieving pregnancy. Please consult your Reproductive Endocrinologist to determine if you have such medical condition.
- 12. Applicant and Co-Applicant must have a combined (if applicable) adjusted gross income under \$175,000
- 13. Applicant and Co-Applicant may not have health insurance that covers the cost of infertility treatments.
